

Weekend Clean Up Guidelines

At least once during the school year, members participate in a **Weekend Clean-Up**. Two WCP families team up and clean the classrooms and the outside toy shed in accordance with the posted task list. The clean-up takes approximately 4 hours.

The following members are exempt from weekend clean-up duties: Executive Board Members and Board Members.

- * Families who have more than one child enrolled will be asked to do another clean up if there are not enough families to cover every weekend.
- * If a family misses the required summer work party they will be asked to do another weekend clean-up in compensation.
- * Members who do not voluntarily sign up for a weekend clean-up will be assigned a date for performing this task by the Assistant House Lead.
- * Members can make arrangements to “buy-out” their weekend clean-up for a fee of \$50.00, recruiting a substitute from the WCP class list (this is the case only if there are volunteers to make up this list). The Assistant House Leader must be notified of the “buy-out” and the name of the substitute,
- * If a scheduled family cannot make their weekend clean-up date they must find a WCP family willing to trade dates. The Assistant House Leader must be notified of the schedule changes.
- * If a scheduled family does not show up for their weekend clean-up, then they will be required to pay the school a fee of \$50.00 and then be re-scheduled to another clean-up date.
- * One week prior to the scheduled weekend clean-up, the Assistant House Leader will provide the responsible parties an email reminder (if possible) and place in their WCP mailbox a packet with specific cleaning instructions and their partnered family’s contact information.
